

Take the metal spoon and bend it in two places to create support for your tea cup.

To bend the top of the spoon, place it in a drawer, then bend gently until you get a 90-degree angle.



To bend the bottom of the spoon, simply bend with your fingers until the spoon portion is flat.





Step 2: Glue

Glue the bottom portion of the spoon to the platter. Be generous with the glue to secure it well enough to hold the weight of the cup.



Wait for the glue to fully dry before moving on to the next step. Take the bent portion of the top of your spoon. Angle it inside your tea cup.



Glue spoon securely to cup. Make sure the cup and spoon are well-balanced, so they can remain stable without support.

Step 3: Arrange Flowers

Take your flowers and any accessories you are using and begin arranging them to cascade from the cup, down the spoon handle, then onto the saucer.



Try placing different colors and sizes of flowers together before adding glue.



How the flowers are arranged is entirely up to you, including how full you want to make the tea cup or the saucer. Simply be sure to cover the spoon entirely.
