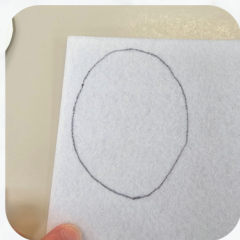


Step 14.

Cut out the Paw template. Place it on the white felt and trace it. Cut out two white felt paws.



Step 15

Cut out the paw pad and toe templates. Place them on the pink felt and trace them. Cut out two pink paw pads and six pink toes.



Step 16

Glue the white paws next to the bunny tale. Then glue the one paw pad and three toes on each paw to create two bunny feet.



Supplies Provided

- 6" embroidery hoop
- 3" embroidery hoop
- 2 contrasting fabric squares
- 1 burlap square
- 1 white pom pom
- 1 piece of white felt
- 1 piece of pink felt



You Will Need:

- Scissors or pinking shears
- Hot glue gun
- Hot glue
- Marker

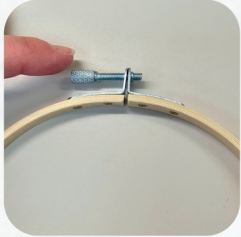
EMBROIDERY
HOOP BUNNY



Instructions

Step 1:

Take your 6 inch embroidery hoop and loosen the screw on top, then separate the two hoops.



Step 2:

Lay the hoop with the screws attached down on a hard surface. Take the square of fabric you want to use for the bunny body and center it over the hoop.



Step 3:

Lay the second hoop over the fabric and push down.



Step 4:

Push down until the fabric is held tightly between the two hoops, then tighten the screws.



Step 5:

Trim the excess fabric.



Step 6:

Repeat process with 3 inch hoop and second fabric square for bunny head.

Step 7:

Glue the 3 inch hoop to the 6 inch hoop with the screws of the 3 inch hoop at the top and the screws of the 6 inch hoop at the bottom.



Step 8:

Take your burlap square and cut it into two triangles.



Step 9:

Take one triangle and pinch two sides together to form a petal shape.



Step 10:

Place hot glue in the seams you create and press together. Trim off any excess fabric below the glued area. Now you have your first ear.



Step 11:

Repeat for second ear.

Step 12:

Glue each ear on the inside of the 3 inch hoop at the top near the screws with the indented part of the ear facing out.



Step 13

Put glue on the 6 inch hoop right above the screw. Glue on your pom pom.
