- 1 mitten template
- 1 grey felt fabric sheet
- Mixture of white and shell buttons
- 2 snowflake buttons
- 1 strip of elastic bandage

You Will Need:

- Scissors
- Craft Glue
- Marker

Try This!

- Use different fabrics or textiles for the background
- Add vintage/different colors or designs buttons
- Use a real sweater cuff from an old sweater

Instructions

Step 1:

Take out the frame insert, line it on top of your felt, draw a line, and trim your felt to fit the frame.



Step 2:

Glue your trimmed felt sheet to the frames' cardboard insert.



Step 3:

Cut out your mitten pattern. Lay it on your felt, then trace it.

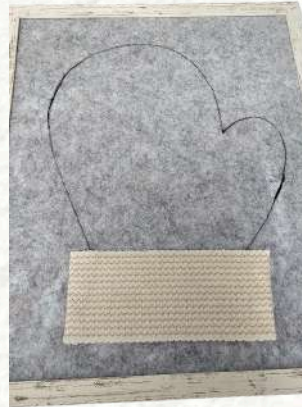


Step 4:

Place your insert back into your frame and secure it.

Step 5:

Fold down and glue each side of your ace bandage, then glue the strip to the bottom of your glove to create a cuff.



Step 6:

Begin outlining your mitten with buttons.



Step 7:

You may decide to lay out your button design before gluing to determine placement. You can also just glue as you go.

Step 8:

Glue down your buttons. Be sure to tuck the bottom layer of buttons under the "cuff."



Step 9:

Add two snowflake buttons to your cuff. Let your mitten dry. Enjoy!
