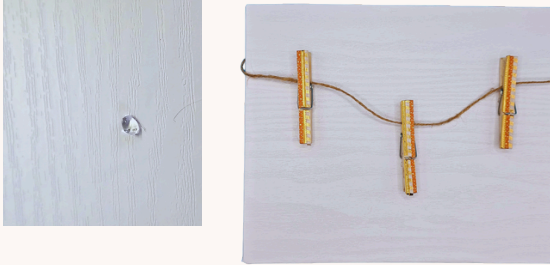


STEP 4

Glue your clothespins to their marked spots. Allow to dry.



STEP 5

Take your twine and glue the middle to the center of the middle clothespin. Loop the remainder through the other two clothespins, then glue to the back to hold sides in place.



STEP 6

Let your project dry. Flip it over and add your adhesive hanging strip.

Supplies Provided

- 1 (8 x 10) foam board
- 1 rectangle faux wood contact paper
- 3 clothespins
- 3 designs washi tape
- 1 string of twine
- 1 adhesive hanging strip set

- Ruler

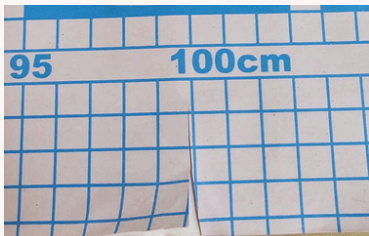


Instructions

The Faux Wood Board

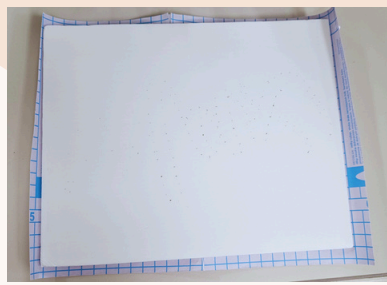
STEP 1

Cut a strip into the protective paper from the middle of your contact paper.



STEP 2

Lay your foam board face down. Center your contact paper (sticky side down) over your foam board.



STEP 3

Carefully unroll the protective paper from your contact paper and press the sticky surface to your foam board.



STEP 4

Flip over your foam board and smooth out contact paper. Fold over the long sides and stick to foam. Fold the corners of the short sides, then fold in as if wrapping a gift to create smooth corners, then stick.

Make it Your Own!

Try adding a saying, buttons, or ribbon. Have fun adding your own touches.

The Clothespin Hangers

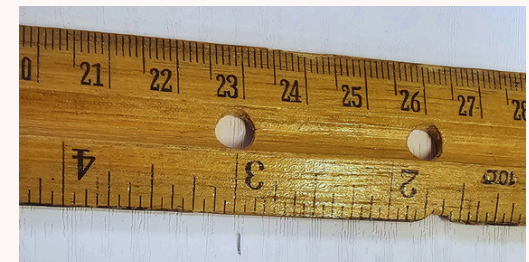
STEP 1

Take your washi tape and place on your clothespin in alternating patterns. Make all three the same or mix the patterns.



STEP 2

Measure and mark for your two side clothespins to be 3 inches down from the top and 2 inches across from the sides.



STEP 3

Measure and mark for your middle clothespin to be 5 inches down from the top and 5 inches over from the sides.
