FINISHING TOUCHES



- Place a dot of glue in the center of your beard inside the ring and glue your wood bead, placing the hole down.
- Push your beard macramé pieces together and even add a dab of glue to hold in place if you like.
- 3.Place glue on both sides of the wood ring above the beard, then place the hat on the ring and slide it down on top of the glue until it meets the beard.
- 4. You now have your own gnome!

MATERIALS PROVIDED:

- Green yarn
- Macrame cord
- 5 cm wood ring
- 3/4 inch wood bead
- Cardboard tube for hat form
- Yarn cutting template

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FREE DIY KIT MACRAMÉ GNOMES

INSTRUCTIONS







- 1. Cut 7 pieces of macramé cord at 11 inches.
- 2. Fold one piece of 11 inch macramé cord in half to make a loop.
- 3. Place loop through the center of the wood ring.
- 4. Pull the tail ends of the yarn through the loop and pull them to the left. Pull tight. Repeat with remaining 6 pieces.
- Comb the macramé cord from the bottom to separate individual strands. When you are finished combing, trim it into a beard shape.











THE HAT 1

 Pick up your cardboard tube hat form. Take one piece of yarn and fold it in half, creating a loop. Slide the loop inside the form (just like with beard).

- 2.Reach through the loop with fingers on your right hand and grab the tail ends of the yarn. Pull them through the loop and out to the right. Repeat with remaining yarn until the tube is completely covered.
- 3.Grab all of the yarn tails in one hand, twist them together, and pull them through the tube. Straighten the tails out to hide the knots inside the tube and create a hat brim.
- 4.Cut a small piece of yarn and tie the top of the yarn above the rim and then trim the excess ends to create a pom-pom effect.
- 5. Use hot glue to apply your four leaf clover embellishment to the hat.
