- Supplies to hang finished garland

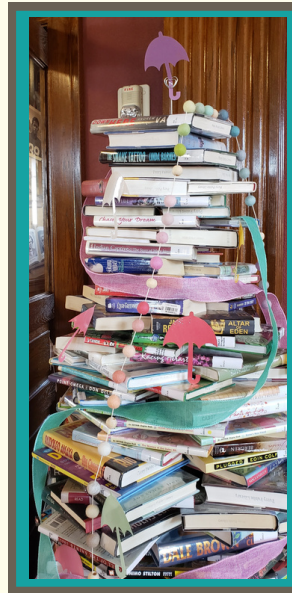

INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

Lay out your color pattern for your wool balls.



STEP 2:

Decide where to use your wood beads.



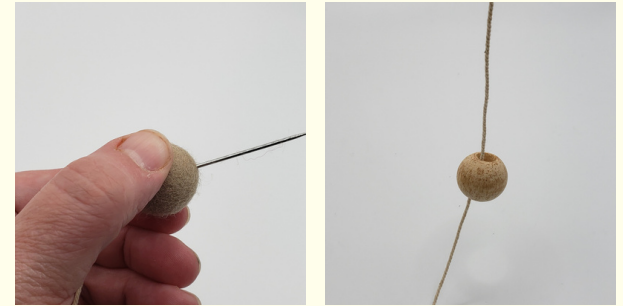
STEP 3:

Thread yarn through darning needle, leaving a short tail. Tie a knot at the other end of your length of yarn.



STEP 4:

Stick your needle through one end of your first wool ball and push through to the other side. Twist until you can pull fully through.



STEP 5:

Repeat step 4, remembering to insert wood beads in between, until finished.
