

## January Craft Club – January 25, 2021

### DIY Coasters

#### Materials:

4 – 4x4 white tiles

2 oz. cup of dishwasher safe Modge Podge

Piece of felt

Super Glue Adhesive

Pictures or Scrapbook paper

Foam Brush

#### Materials Not Included:

Scissors or Exacto Knife

#### Steps:

1. You'll want to start by cutting out the paper for the top of the tiles. Just line up the tile on the paper and cut around the edges with the x-acto knife/scissors.
2. Next, take the modge podge with your foam brush and cover the top of the tile completely - make sure you get all the way to the edges because you don't want the paper to lift at all. Then set the paper on top of the modge podged tile. Make sure the paper lays flat and there aren't any wrinkles or bubbles. Brush on more modge podge on top of the paper. Also brush around the edges to make sure it is sealed onto the tile.
3. Repeat the process with each of the tiles and various pictures/papers you have chosen.
4. Next day, add another coat of the modge podge to the tiles. I found that this works to really adhere the paper to the tile.
5. Optional Step: Choose an acrylic paint to pull one of the colors out of the paper. I painted the edges and the bottoms.
